On Spiritual Mind Treatment

All the words, thoughts, affirmations, and denials, the declarations in a spiritual mind treatment, are for the purpose of bringing the consciousness of the one treating to a higher level of spiritual acceptance. Words are molds. It is the consciousness which flows through them that fills these molds with a living substance.

The important factor, then, is whether or not the form that one uses causes their mind to believe. They may use a process of reasoning, of logic, or of argument with their self. They may go through a process of affirmation and denial. But always the process should tend to-

ward the gaining of an inward realization, a feeling, a sense, an atmosphere of peace, harmony, and protection.

Their entire treatment is based on the assumption that there is a spiritual pattern at the center of everything. The perfect was always there — it was implanted by the Spirit. The imperfect has been added by the human mind. What the human mind has put there, it can take away. What the Divine has implanted cannot be uprooted; it can only appear to be covered up. Spiritual mind practice is an uncovering of the Divine Nature.

CREATIVE PURPOSE
